

## Charges to Patients January 2020

Please Note: any services required urgently, or which take longer than normal to complete may be charged at a higher rate

Non-NHS Services	FEE
Medicals – standard medicals within 3 x 10min slots <i>Charity medicals – ONLY if patient is paying him/herself £75</i>	£110
Fostering/Adoption Medicals	£180
Other – On a 'per minute' Dr time basis if requested by the doctor <i>NB – note we do not complete Power of Attorney</i>	£300 per hour
General Practitioner Reports (GPR)	£120
Private Sick Note / Private Prescription	£15
Gun Licence Form	£30 - renewal £50 – new request
All letters / questionnaires / fitness to travel or attend school / holiday cancellations / driving licence / photographs / etc	£30 NB – the Dr retains the right to charge more if the information required is longer than the usual. Patient will be informed before doing the form
Private Blood Tests - price on application	£25 + lab fees

## Travel Vaccinations – January 2020

MUST be paid for in advance

	Charges
Rabies (course x 3)	£60.00 per vaccine to be paid in advance
Hepatitis B - travel purposes (vaccines X 3) Plus Blood Test if required @ £100	£35 per vaccine For employer requested and clinical reasons see below
Hepatitis B for non-travel purposes – <i>At Risk occupations</i> It is the EMPLOYER's duty to pay – All vaccinations / blood tests must be paid for IN ADVANCE by either the employer or the patient. <i>Post exposure / bites</i> Hepatitis B is provided free of charge under NHS services for at risk conditions. Eg post animal bites	

**The following vaccines are to be paid for on request of the vaccine as it needs to be ordered in specially & are non-refundable. Charges are indicative only & need to be checked individually**

Tickbourne Encephalitis	
Adult	Approx. £80.00
Child	Approx £75.00
Japanese Encephalitis (vaccines x 2)	Approx £95 per vaccine
Meningitis	Approx £60
<i>Yellow Fever – We no longer offer yellow fever, patients will need to go to an authorised centre / ring a travel clinic</i>
